Global Jet is proud to announce record-breaking growth in its Aircraft Management department, having secured over 17 new management contracts since Spring 2024. This milestone reflects the company's unwavering commitment to excellence in private aviation.

The newly added aircraft include a Citation Latitude, Praetor 500, Gulfstream 200, Falcon 2000LXS, Falcon 900LX, Falcon 7X, Gulfstream GV, Gulfstream G650, Global 6000, four Global 7500s, three Gulfstream G700s, and notably, an Airbus ACJ319neo.



This surge in fleet expansion reinforces Global Jet's position as a world leader in the management of ultra-long-range business jets. The company now operates one of the largest fleets of Global 7500s, with nine in service, alongside ten Gulfstream G650/ERs. These aircraft offer discerning clients a superior travel experience defined by cutting-edge technology, exceptional comfort, and unmatched global range. Notably, three of these new arrivals are equipped with Starlink Wi-Fi, offering high-speed connectivity even at cruising altitude.

Looking ahead, the Aircraft Management team is preparing for the addition of several highly anticipated aircraft, including two Falcon 6X and a Global 8000, further enhancing Global Jet's capability to meet the evolving needs of its clientele.

Global Jet continues to diversify its charter fleet, having recently added nine exceptional aircraft. Among the new additions are a brand-new Praetor 500, a Latitude, a Bombardier Global Express XRS, a Falcon 7X, two Falcon 900LXs, a Gulfstream 200, Gulfstream 600, and a Gulfstream G650ER, further enriching its already versatile fleet.

Among these recent additions, the Falcon 900LX stands out for its perfect balance of performance and comfort. Manufactured in December 2023, the aircraft is configured to welcome up to 14 passengers and is tailored for both business and leisure travel. The interior shows contemporary elegance, with a bespoke design that combines high-end materials and precision craftsmanship. Technologically advanced, the cabin features cutting-edge soundproofing, intuitive ambient lighting, and full connectivity capabilities, including high-speed Ka-band internet, Bluetooth integration, HDMI interfaces, and Airshow. Designed for seamless productivity and relaxation, the Falcon 900LX offers an exceptionally quiet and connected environment for passengers throughout their journey.

Equally remarkable is the Gulfstream G650ER, a 2019 model now based in Paris. Known for its ultra-long-range performance and refined cabin environment, the G650ER seats up to 16 passengers in three luxurious living zones. The interior is meticulously designed to maximize space and comfort on long-haul flights, offering fully reclining seats, a conference

area, and dedicated rest zones. Passengers enjoy a host of entertainment options, including integrated iPads, Netflix, USB-C charging ports, and HDMI connectivity. The G650ER also provides one of the quietest cabins in its class, enhanced by a low cabin altitude and 100% fresh air replenished every two to three minutes, ensuring optimal well-being and comfort at cruising altitude.

From a market perspective

The business jet sales and acquisitions market in 2025 is stabilizing after the post-pandemic surge, with strong growth in new aircraft deliveries, driven by OEMs like Bombardier and Embraer, and a dynamic pre-owned segment adapting to rising inventory levels and evolving buyer preferences. Demand remains high for large-cabin, long-range jets, particularly among private users, while pricing trends show mixed results across different categories. Despite economic pressures such as tariffs and ongoing supply chain challenges, the global market is projected to grow steadily through 2032, supported by rising demand, fleet modernization, and a growing emphasis on efficiency and sustainability.
